Community Liaison Update

Aside from the ExtraGive we were very busy in the fall of 2023. In September we participated in the United Way Lunch and Learn program hosted by Meals on Wheels. This event gave us an opportunity to meet and talk with people in the community about Ambassadors for Hope's mission.

In October we took part in the Friends Helping Friends one day fundraiser at Boscov's department store. We were able to raise over **\$600!**

We also participated in the Children's Systems Conference held in October at the Lancaster-Lebanon IU 13. This conference provided Ambassadors for Hope with wonderful exposure to diverse child-serving organizations working across Lancaster County.
